Instructor Audit (PEC Basic SG/SL and/or Core Compliance) (Included)

The SafeGulf / SafeLandUSA audit is an Operator requirement. The classroom portion of the audit is performed on the fourth day of the TTT. Our PEC master instructor will have each student teach a section of our PEC Basic SafeGulf/SafeLandUSA and/or PEC Core Compliance to the other instructors. You will then be graded on your performance and presentation skills, making sure that you have asked appropriate questions and that you are knowledgeable about the materials. The audit is performed every three years.

Cost: \$750.00 for the first instructor and each additional instructor is \$100.00.
After the course a PEC auditor will come and audit your facility. This is to ensure you have a good training environment, a secure system to store student test, etc.

Printing License: (Optional)

The printing license gives your company the right to print student workbooks instead of purchasing them from PEC. When you achieve the Train the Trainer certification, you will receive a CD with material that will allow you to print all of your student workbooks.

Cost: \$500 / yr.
