PEC Basic/SafeGulf/SafeLandUSA Orientation Train the Trainer

This is a two day program for an instructor level authorization. The PEC Basic Orientation Train-the-Trainer course allows an instructor to administer the PEC Basic Orientation course which is a SafeGulf and SafeLandUSA accredited program. PEC Basic Orientation was designed to take the place of multiple Operator orientation courses and to give each student a general idea of safety issues in the oil and gas industry - upstream, downstream, onshore, and offshore.

Trainer Qualifications and Pre-requisites

- High School Diploma or GED.
- Experience in classroom instruction.
- Minimum of 6 months experience in Oil & Gas Industry.
- Minimum of 6 months HSE experience as a trainer or member of safety staff.
- At least 50% of your job with current employer dedicated to providing services related to the health and safety program(s) for your company.
- Successfully completed the Basic Orientation program as a student or be tested to ensure that you fully understand the information provided in the program.

- To prepare an instructor to train students to know what types of additional training they will need in order to work for the various Operators at both onshore and offshore facilities.
- To prepare an instructor to create a mindset in each student that will help them play an active role in the safety program at their work facility.

PEC Core Compliance is also a SafeGulf and SafeLandUSA accredited program. It also prepares them to teach the PEC Basic Orientation course as a standalone course.

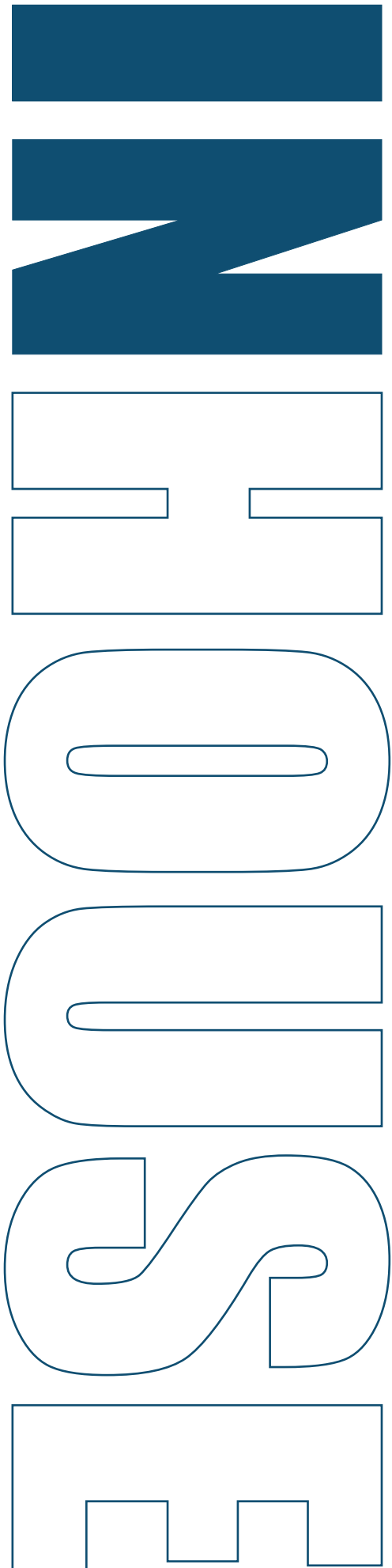
The PEC Core Compliance program brings together the health, safety and environmental training modules (OSHA and BOEMRE) most requested by oilfield Operators and other host employers. This in depth training program can ensure that your employees are compliant with your customers' OSHA and BOEMRE safety training requirements. Material presentation is structured to build on common content in a high intensity three day format. The instructor led interactive training will allow you to teach other personnel in PEC Core Compliance. PEC Core TTT also includes instructor materials and authorization to instruct the yearly PEC Core Refresher (8 hrs.). Because many components of PEC Core Compliance expire annually, a refresher is required to keep the course current.

Important Instructor Information

Audits

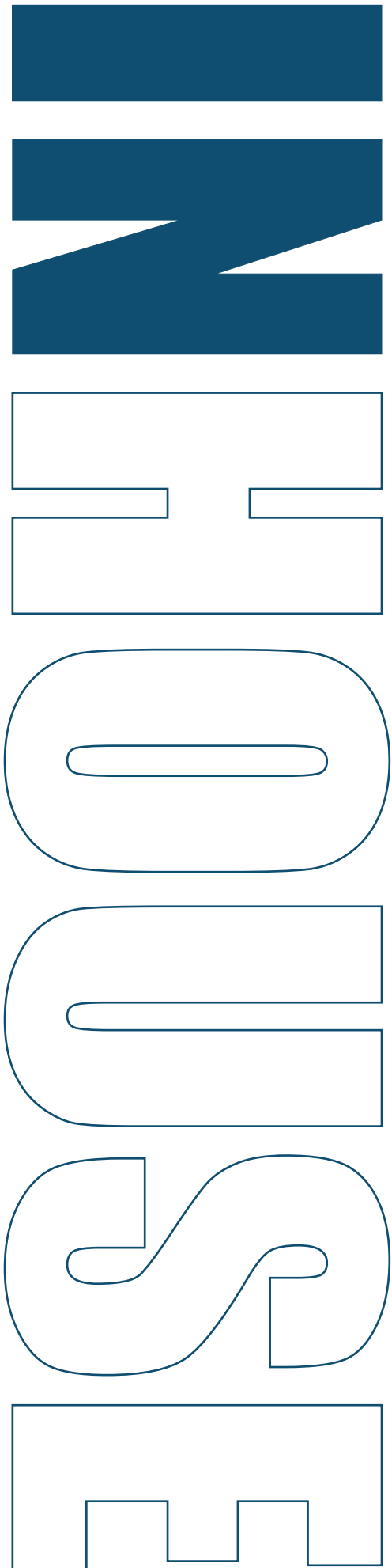
The SafeGulf / SafeLandUSA instructor and facility audits are Operator requirements that verify the material is taught correctly, consistently, and at a suitable facility. Upon successful completion of your Train the Trainer, PEC Premier will send an auditor to your facility to conduct a facility audit.

Instructor Audit

Your instructor audit will be conducted during your Train the Trainer. Our PEC master instructor will have you demonstrate your teaching capabilities to the other instructors using a module from PEC Basic or Core Compliance. You will be evaluated on your performance, presentation skills, and knowledge of the material.

Facility Audit

PEC Premier will send an auditor to your facility to ensure it has a positive learning environment, adequate lighting, suitable ventilation, secure location to store student testing materials, etc. Every three years your facility must be re-audited to ensure your training facility meets requirements. The costs for your facility audit are as follows:

- \$750.00 for your first active instructor
- \$100.00 each additional active instructor
- You will be invoiced for your facility audit every 3 years for all active instructors listed within our database. Please contact us if you have recently had a change of instructors to avoid unnecessary invoices.

Instructor Update

To maintain an active Instructor status, you must update annually. Annual Instructor Update requirements include:

- Instructor fee of \$375.00
- Instructor Acknowledgement and Signature form
- Refresher exam based on your course of instruction
- Attend the annual PEC/Premier Instructor update webinar

Every year you will need to acquire CUs which are activity credit units. You will receive an update log upon completion of your Instructor Authorization Program which outlines these requirements in more detail. CUs can be achieved through teaching PEC Core and Basic classes, earning certifications, attending training courses, and attending various industry meetings and conferences.
